Weekly Inspection Log (Continued)

Pavement:

Check for cracks in the runway, taxiway, ramp, apron and access road area. Cracks with grass growing through it. Any cracks wider than 1/2 inch.

Airfield:

Checking the airfield: Grass no higher than 6 inches: Grass Field Runway grass no higher than 4 inches; Windsock in good condition, not frayed; Segmented Circle painting not faded; Drainage, indicate any area with standing water; Tie-downs, chains in good condition and painting not faded; During winter season snow no higher than 3 inches dry and 1/2 inch slush

Airport Perimeter:

Fence condition, any breaks or weak points in the fence; Signage- is all signs on the airport readable, and sign in town indicating airport is visible and in good condition; Unicom- were applicable, loud and clear.

Markings:

Runway, Taxiway, Taxilane, Ramp, and Apron markings are in good visible condition. Indicate if markings are faded and need no paint: Runway lights, Taxiway lights, and Approach Lights indicate where the light is out.
